In Year 1 We have been incredibly busy rehearsing for our Christmas performance next week! We are very excited to show our grown-ups all of our hard work. Back in class, we have been working on some tricky Maths problems involving inverse operations. We have also looked at how to use the -ing suffix in English!	In Year 2 Year 2 have used part whole models to represent calculations and then used these to write inverse calculations.
