OUR LEARNING

In Reception...We started our week by discovering an egg in our Outdoor Area. We soon realised it was a dragon's egg which had been left behind! We have been keeping a close eye on the egg all week, I wonder what will happen over the weekend? We have been exploring with the bee-bots in Maths



this week. We have been using the vocabulary 'forwards', 'backwards' and 'code' to help our friends to move the bee-bot. We have also been creating maps of Penketh and discussing our favourite places!

In Year 1... This week in Maths, Year 1 have been solving word problems linked to addition. They used bar models and part-whole models to help them to work out their answers! In RE, we have been looking at what is needed for a Baptism to take place. In Art, we were drawing flowers based on the art work of artist Georgia O'Keeffe. The children used oil pastels to bring their flowers to life. We were very impressed with their artistic abilities!

In Year 2...Year 2 have had another wonderful week of learning! In Maths, we have explored different arrays and can independently write two multiplication sentences, as well as two repeated addition sentences alongside any array. In English, the children have written their own poems about what they would like to be when they grow up. In Geography, we loved locating and naming the five oceans and had lots of fun learning about the continent of Europe!

In Year 3... This week in Year 3, we have planned, researched and written our fact files about endangered animals. In Maths, we have been using problem solving skills to complete our addition and subtraction unit. In PSHE, we have been learning about what diversity is and how to show respect to others. In Geography, we have been discussing the land use of Warrington and Cheshire and created a bar chart based on our findings. In Music, we have been singing along to different rhythms and in RE, we have been learning about what gives us pride. Year 3 particularly enjoyed the song 'Proud' by Heather Small and giving examples of who they were proud of and why!

In Year 4... Another busy week in Year 4. We have been writing diaries as island villagers, been Biologists looking for plants and animals in their habitats, learning that multiplication is commutative and how to multiply and divide by 10 and 100 using a place value chart and created silhouette pictures for the school's PAN art display. Alongside all of this, we are continuing to work hard on TTRS with over half the class having gone green and with our reading using the Collins Hub to access books on line.

In Year 5... Year 5 have had a busy week mastering long division, including some equations with remainders! We have learnt how to use brackets to show parenthesis and will include this learning within our biographies. In computing lessons, we have created our own (challenging!) times table quizzes. Our team building skills continue to grow each week whilst completing our amazing Forest School sessions. Have a lovely, well-earned, weekend!

In Year 6... This week, Year 6 enjoyed learning about 'Holy Week' in RE. We explored the importance of Palm Sunday, Maundy Thursday, Good Friday and Easter Sunday to Christians and created our own Holy Week animation strips to present our knowledge of what happens on each of these days. We continue to work hard in our English and Maths lessons and particularly enjoyed the opportunity to win some cookies this week in a 3D shape net-building competition!
