## OUR LEARNING

**In Reception...**Reception have been very busy keeping our school grounds tidy by picking up litter and making litter posters. We have been looking at one more and one less in Maths and using our number track to help us work out answers. In Phonics we have learnt lots of new digraphs and tri-graphs and we have been applying these into our writing!

**In Year 1...** This week, Year 1 have been very busy again, especially with their Foundation subjects! The children have loved learning how to log onto our new school Chromebooks. They worked in pairs to fill in their username and passwords. In DT, the children have made their

own overnight oats, which has been so much fun! And in PSHE, we have been looking at different ways to stay healthy and active! Overall, a very fun week had by all!



In Year 3... This week in Year 3, we have worked incredibly hard with our Maths when adding and subtracting 3 digit numbers! In English, we have been learning about prefixes, fronted adverbials and writing our own set of instructions too. In History, we have been learning about where in the world the four ancient civilisations were and how the equator had an impact on their day-to-day lives. In DT, we have tested some sandwiches in preparation for our upcoming mini sandwich creations, we especially enjoyed the cheese and ham toastie! In PSHE, we discussed family changes and the advice we would give to other people when in tough times. Finally, this week in Forest School, we made clay sculptures and made animal dens too.

**In Year 5...**What a fantastic trip to Safety Central we had! From shopping for a healthy meal in the Co-op, to watching a laptop catch fire and setting alight a duvet cover. We learnt so much and will expand upon this knowledge over the coming weeks. Within English lessons, we have been writing dialogue between characters, using inverted commas accurately. Our making and taste testing of taquito's has created excitement for next week's lesson following our own designs. Some of us have even made our own at home! **In Year 2...**Year 2 have had another fantastic week! In Maths, we have enjoyed learning new methods to bridge through 10 when adding and subtracting and although this has been tricky, we have shown lots of determination and resilience! In English, we have written amazing diary entries as George. In History, we have created a timeline of events of the Great Fire of London.

**In Year 4...** Year 4 were very keen in Science to make their own electrical circuits that made a light bulb illuminate and some of them even managed to add a switch to turn the light bulb on and off. In History, they have continued to learn about the Roman invasion of Britain. This week they learnt about who tried to stop the invasion and who was the Roman enemy. They are continuing to amaze me with their times table knowledge and recall with some children completing 50 questions in under a minute! Finally, after the excitement of last week's pie tasting, this week the children have designed their own fruit pie, choosing their filling and creating a pattern for their pie lid!

**In Year 6...** This week, Year 6 have impressed us with their thoughtful discussions in PSHE about how information and images on social media can be manipulated and the dangers this poses. They have also been keen scientists, exploring how animals and plants adapt to their environments. We have continued to explore our text 'The Selfish Giant' in English and are producing some beautiful pieces of writing. Well done Year 6, enjoy a well-deserved, restful weekend!
