
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New Houses

OUR LEARNING

In Reception...We have had another lovely week in Reception, embedding all of our routines and working hard in our play. We have started our reading sessions and the children have loved looking at their new book along with impressing us all with their discussions. We have also enjoyed learning about Rosa Parks this week, as part of Black History Month. We learnt about her story and how brave she was!

In Year 1... This week, as part of Black History Month, Year 1 have been learning about the life of Floella Benjamin. We read her story 'Coming to England' and found out more about her homeland of Trinidad. We have been writing fact files about Floella and completing some art work based on the illustrations from her book. It has been lots of fun to focus on someone very special and important!

In Year 2... Year 2 have had a wonderful week and are working incredibly hard. In Maths, we have learnt how to count in steps of ten from a given number. This week for our Black History Month unit, we have learnt about the life of Mary Seacole. We created portraits of her and produced amazing diary entries from her perspective. In English, we have used noun phrases to describe a character.

In Year 3...This week in Year 3, we have really enjoyed learning about Marcus Rashford as we celebrated his great achievements and the changes he has made for children across the country. We have started reading his book 'You can do it' as our new class story and we are enjoying learning more about all of the different ways we can be the best versions of ourselves. In English, we have been using our role play skills to help with dialogue in our writing and have been great detectives, making some very interesting inferences about out text.

In Year 4...As we welcome in October, Year 4 have been celebrating Black History Month. We have been learning about Matthew Henson, who was the first black man to reach the North Pole. We talked about the resilience, bravery and determination he would have had to use. We have also begun work on our non-chronological reports about gorillas. We can't wait to complete them!

In Year 5...Year 5 have been learning about Arthur Wharton, the first ever black professional footballer. We have created fact files and artwork to celebrate Black History Month to reflect this. Within spelling lessons, we've been learning about contractions and applying this knowledge to our writing. We have planned our own 'Lost Thing' stories and will write and edit them next week. We are expanding on our place value knowledge; quiz us on largest and smallest numbers within one million, we are becoming experts!

In Year 6... This week, Year 6 have enjoyed exploring healthy and unhealthy habits in PSHE and Christian attitudes to salvation in RE - we've loved listening to the insightful and empathetic views they've shared during our class discussions. A special thank you to our parents for such a lovely Parents Evening, we are so pleased you've been able to see all your child's hard work so far!
