## OUR LEARNING

In Reception...Reception have been super busy this week! We have been engrossed in our new non-fiction book, 'Hello Penguin'. We have been writing our own fact files about different species of penguin and have created some beautiful paintings of penguins. In Phonics, we have learnt all about compound words and we have been using our phonics brains to write these too!

In Year 1...This week, Year 1 have been using our Chromebooks to design their own pictures. In Science, the children have carried out an experiment to see which materials are the strongest! We loved our Great Fire of London workshop, alongside Year 2, which has brought to a close a very enjoyable History topic!

In Year 2...In Maths, we have worked hard when adding and subtracting two 2-digit numbers. In English, we have created our own settings for our stories and we have used lots of excellent vocabulary! In Art, we have used watercolours to prepare a background, learning how to draw cherry blossom trees and are excited to draw this on the foreground. We also loved the Great Fire of London workshop. It was so much fun!

In Year 3... This week in Year 3, we have been working hard in Maths with our addition and subtraction methods. In English, we have been rewriting alternative endings to stories in preparation for creating our own historical narratives. In PE, we have been working on our gymnastics skills using lots of equipment. In My Happy Mind, we have been focusing on celebrating our character strengths, identifying and celebrating each other's strengths! We thoroughly enjoyed this week's Chinese Dance workshops, learning new skills and celebrating other cultures!

In Year 4...In English, Year 4 have been writing letters, as Tranio and Livia, back to their parents, focusing on the informal language of a letter to a loved one. They have been refining their subtraction skills in Maths, using column subtraction with multiple exchanges to solve problems. Meanwhile in Science, they have learnt how make a break in a circuit where a switch can be added so the light bulb can be switched on and off. The children were fascinated to learn that Warrington was actually a Roman goods depot where items were stored and moved on to the Roman fort in Chester. The children's favourite part of the week was learning a handkerchief and fan dance as part of our Chinese New Year celebrations.

In Year 5... Year 5 have started writing their fabulous mythical stories and we can't wait to share them with you all next Thursday at 9:30am! In Maths, we have been learning about factors, multiples and square numbers. We learnt about Chinese New Year and performed a dragon dance! We made parachutes in Science to learn about air resistance. We have filled our marble jar so, on Wednesday, we will be having our class reward of a pyjama party and film!

In Year 6... This week, Year 6 loved taking part in the Chinese New Year dragon dance workshop. In English, we have started to plan our final piece, a re-tell of 'The Selfish Giant', but from a different characters perspective. In Maths, we have grappled with percentages and two-step word problems. Our curriculum work has included; exploring the Amazon Rainforest in Geography, learning about Hajj in RE and Charles Darwin in Science! Well done Year 6!....
